



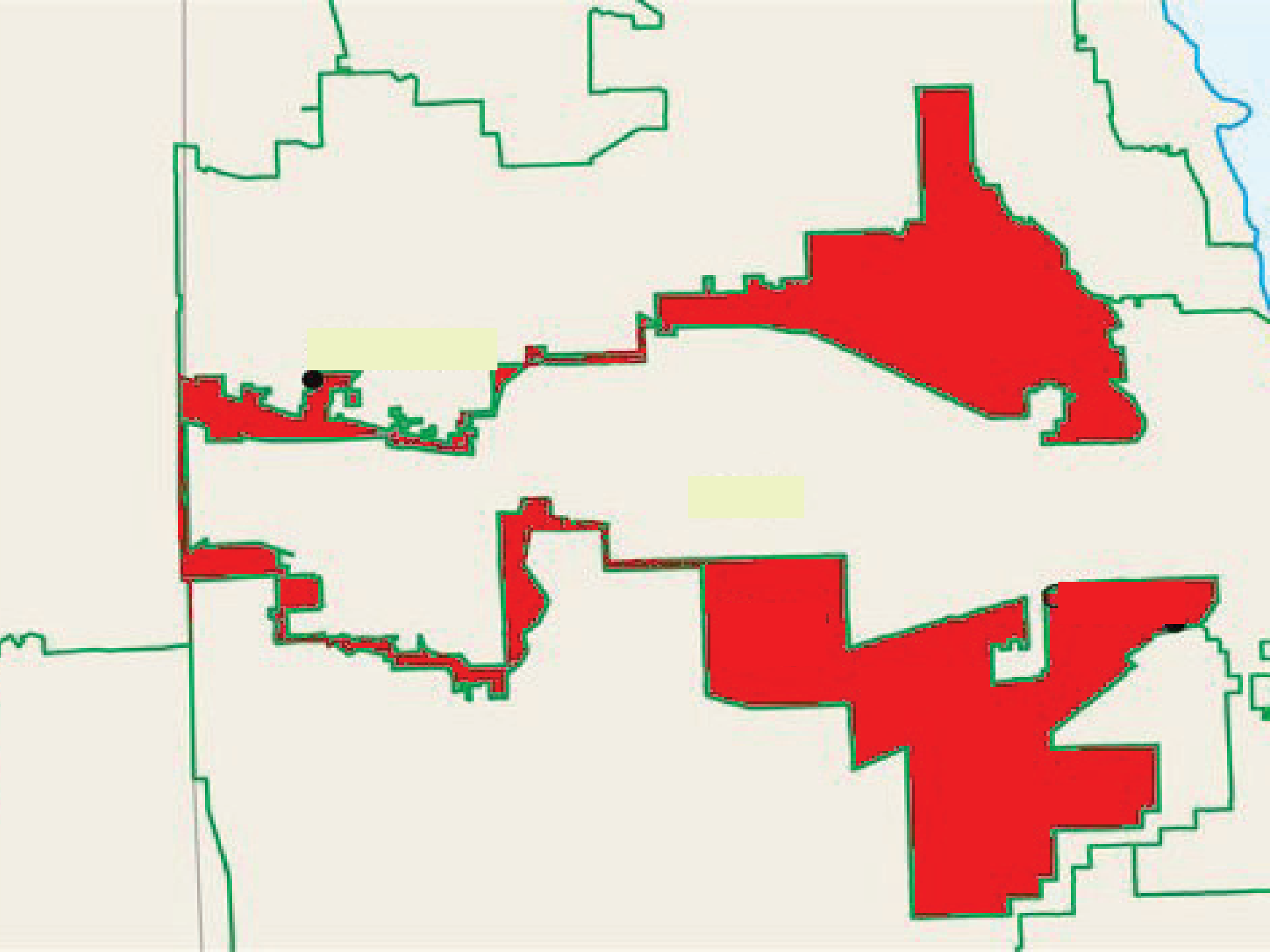

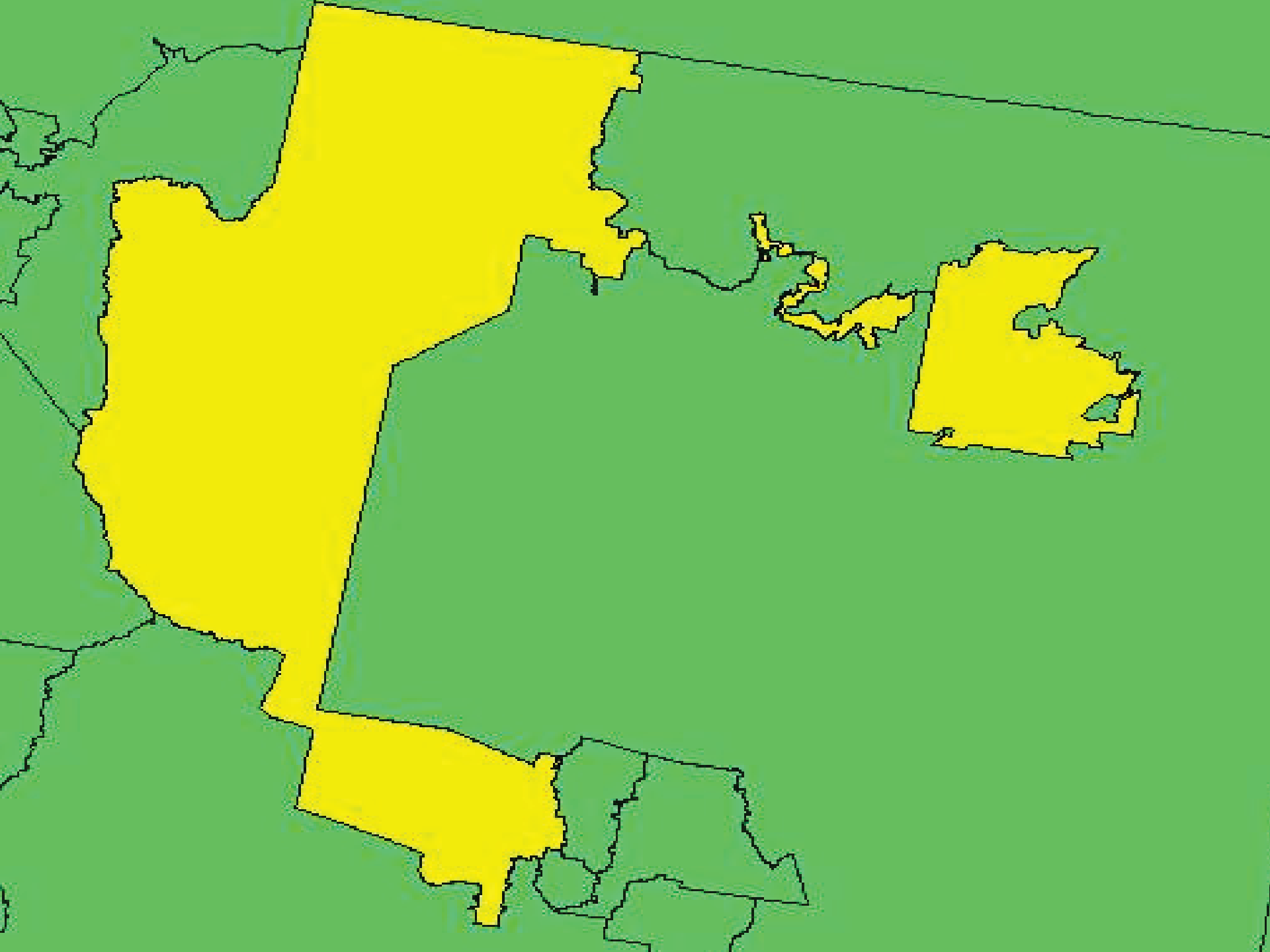

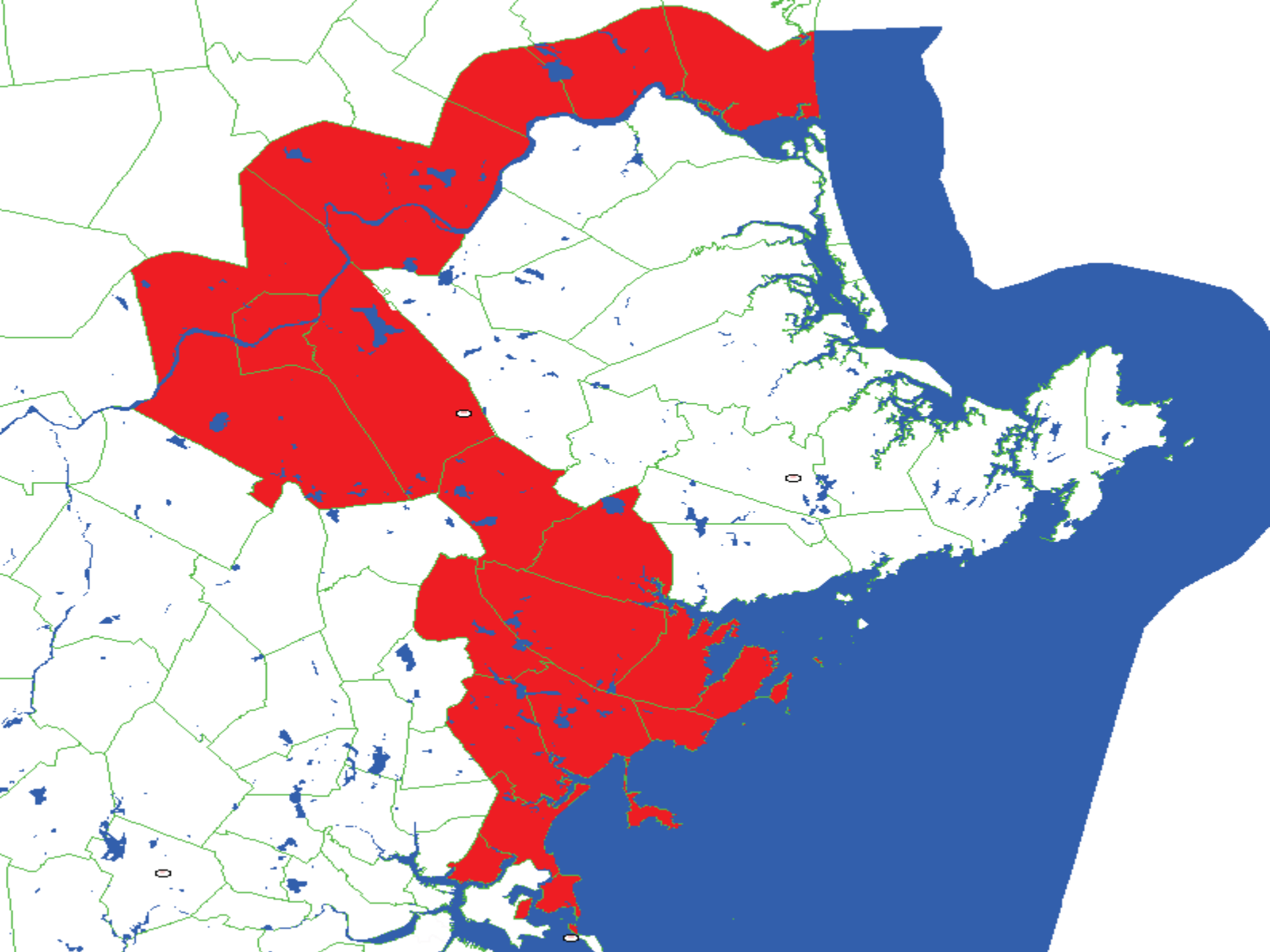

BROOKINGS

- Arrival of the data is imminent
- Process varies from state to state
- Legislative committees are being formed and will start to adopt guidelines soon
- Republicans in best position in modern era of redistricting

Key Points & 2011 Changes

- Constitutionally mandated
- Constrained by federal and state laws
- Every state has a different approach
- Decisions about guidelines and public involvement are being made now
- Changes in 2011:
 - Prisoners
 - California
 - Public access and transparency
 - ACS
 - Data and software post-redistricting
