



# Change in the number of 20-35 year olds: 2000 to 2005




#### Growth in Family Households with Own Children under 18: 1990-2005




### Marriage Among 20-30 Year Olds: 2005




### Married with Spouse Absent as Share of All Married: 2005




### Persons Divorced as a Share of Persons Ever Married: 2005



## Unmarried Women with a Birth in the Past Year: 2005




