



Ages 15-29 (Mean scores)




Life Satisfaction by Gender - Country



- In the city or areas where you live, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the availability of good affordable housing?
 - Median Satisfied: 51%
 - Median Dissatisfied: 44%

- Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with your current housing, dwelling, or place you live?
 - Median Satisfied: 58%
 - Median Dissatisfied: 39%
 - Egypt: 60% Dissatisfied
 - Iran: 83% Dissatisfied

In the city or area where you live, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the education system or the schools?






Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the efforts to increase the number and quality of jobs?




Do you currently have a job or work either paid or unpaid?




Thinking about the job situation in the city or area where you live today, would you say that it is now a good time or a bad time to find a job?




Is the city or area where you live a good place or not a good place to live for entrepreneurs forming new businesses?



Do you believe the current economic conditions in the city or area where you live are good, or not?




Do you think that the economic conditions in the city or area where you live, as a whole, are getting better or getting worse?



Do you believe that children in this country are treated with respect and dignity, or not?




Do most children in this country have the opportunity to learn and grow every day, or not?




Giving back to the community?

Have you volunteered your time to an organization in the past month?




Have you helped a stranger or someone you didn't know who needed help?




Would you like to move?

Ideally, if you had the opportunity, would you like to move permanently to another country, or would you prefer to continue living in this country?




To which country would you like to move to?




What the Problem is: Perceptions associated with Anti-American Sentiment




Below is a list of possible actions that the US could take. For each one, I am interested in knowing to what extent this action might significantly improve your opinion of the US.

Who would you personally rather see elected president of the United States?


